The Criminal Justice Substance Misuse Service (CJSM) delivers engagement, referral and treatment for those in the criminal justice system with problematic drug and/or alcohol use. There are a number of teams:

- The Specialist Substance Misuse Investigation Team

The service is also responsible for the commissioned Prostitute Support Programme and the Women's Diversion Service.
